


SUBJECT: 2020 Dues Notice

The Upper Peninsula RC&D Council is requesting **\$350.00** from each county to support the operations of the U.P. RC&D in 2020. Our Council has active projects in all 15 UP Counties, as well as several multi-county projects. The UP RC&D Council tends to keep a pretty low profile, but the impacts of our ability to bring grant funds to the UP, and spend those grant funds to help solve conservation problems have been enormous. In just the past 9 years, we have secured 12 grants totaling \$3,487,130. We have also secured another \$3,073,614 in non-federal matching funds for a total investment of \$6,560,744. We are very proud of the role we have played in bringing tax dollars back to the UP, but we could not have done it without the contributions and expertise that we have received from our project partners. U.P. County Conservation Districts, and state and federal agency partners have played a major role in securing these grants. Most of our federal grants have required matching non-federal funds, and many of those match contributions have been provided by local county conservation districts. As partners in our projects, we have been able to pass grant funds through to them to conduct landowner education and outreach, invasive species mapping and management activities, followed by native habitat restoration. In those same 9 years, we have passed \$392,538 in grant funds to conservation district partners, and paid contractors another \$898,117 to conduct invasive species treatments across the UP. We have also provided thousands of dollars of supplies and educational materials to our conservation district partners and used additional grant funds to pay our own staff to coordinate and implement these UP-wide projects. The funds passed through to conservation districts help support jobs in their organizations and help them achieve their local county conservation goals. These values will be even more impressive when we finish spending the grant funds we have received in the past few years. Some of those funds have not yet been passed through to partners or invested in treatment, restoration and protection work. Highlights of this work include conducting garlic mustard management on 478 acres throughout the UP, mapping over 2,400 acres of non-native phragmites, and securing the necessary DEQ permits and landowner permission to treat more than 2,100 of those acres, educating thousands of UP landowners about invasive species issues, securing funding to conserve over 3,700 acres of migratory bird habitat, and providing leadership and financial resources to all 5 Cooperative Invasive Species Management Areas that work throughout the region. Without these investments in managing invasive species in the UP, it's safe to say that some of them would have caused much more economic and ecological damage.

However, most of these grant funds are for specific projects and may not legally be used to cover general council operational expenses. Funds provided by the 15 sponsoring County Board of Commissioners are used for meeting expenses, printing, postage, insurance, office space and administrative assistance. Without the support that we receive from the UP counties in the form of dues, we will not be able to sustain our Council and will not be able to bring these much-needed competitive grant funds to the UP to help solve these important ecological problems. When the UP RC&D Council was created back in the 1970s, the counties were the sponsoring entities and at that time we had a Coordinator which was a federal employee, federally funded office space, and other federal support. This federal assistance to our Council was terminated 9 years ago, and we have been in the process of modifying the way we operate since then to find the best format for financial sustainability. The UP Council now meets quarterly with half the meetings being held at the Council office in Marquette, and the remaining meetings held by teleconference call. Your county representative, and all other interested persons, may attend the meetings in person or call in to the meetings. Modifications to our council structure were finalized when we approved changes to our bylaws at the UP RC&D Council meeting on June 6, 2014, and these bylaws are available on our website.

For more information about these UP-wide invasive plant projects and how we are working with your conservation districts and other state and federal partners, visit our website at www.uprcd.org. We thank you for your support and interest in local and regional resource conservation activities, and look forward to partnering with the UP counties to seek additional funding for future projects.

SERVICE AGREEMENT

This Agreement for Services is between Baraga County, with primary offices located in L'Anse, Michigan and Mr. John Pekkala, an independent contractor, of Hancock, Michigan.

The Baraga County Equalization Department is the County Enforcing Agent in Baraga County for Part 91, Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control (SESC), of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, PA 451 of 1994, as amended (NREPA), and the rules promulgated under Part 91.

The County of Baraga is contracting with a qualified individual for the purpose of administration and enforcement of the Part 91 program from March 1st, 2020 to August 1st, 2020 (this includes, but is not limited to: review of permit applications and SESC plans, permit issuance, conduct inspections, and provide for compliance and enforcement efforts). Mr. Pekkala has several years of experience with this program, has agreed to provide these services for the County of Baraga, and has the current training certificates as required under Part 91, SESC:

- 1. Construction Storm Water Certified Operator/Soil Erosion Inspector
 - a. Certificate # 16847, Expires July 1, 2023
- 2. SESC Plan Review and Design Certification
 - a. Certificate # 01172, Expires July 1, 2023

The Baraga County Equalization Department remains the County Enforcing Agency for Part 91, as a county office is required to house this position. All responsibility and liability for providing an adequate Part 91, SESC program remains with Baraga County.

All permit fees collected by Mr. Pekkala shall be deposited with the Baraga County Treasurer in a timely manner.

Nothing contained in this Agreement shall be construed as creating an employer/employee, principle agent, partnership or join venture arrangement between the parties, and it is further understood that the contractor is not entitled to any of the benefits or compensation afforded to county employees.

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INTRODUCTION – THE REASON FOR THIS REVISION

The State Survey and Remonumentation Act, 1990 PA 345, was revised on June 12, 2014 by 2014 PA 166. This revision, among other things, reinstated the State Survey and Remonumentation Commission and required them in Section 8 to promulgate the rules and guide the counties to formalize a REVISED COUNTY PLAN. Issues identified in the law and by the commission to be specifically addressed are:

- A. A plan to remonument all of the original Public Land Survey corners, property controlling corners and protracted corners. The plan must also list other corners to be included or excluded. MCL 54.268 (2)(a)&(c). If an explicit plan is included in a previous Plan, then outline any modifications that may have occurred since the last update.
- B. A perpetual monument maintenance plan. MCL 54.268 (2)(d) The Land Corner Recordation Act, 1970 PA 74, outlines when a Land Corner Recordation Certificate must be filed. In order to formalize the local practice, the county must define “as described.”
- C. A peer review group. MCL 54.268 (e)
 - i. Qualifications for peer review group membership must be defined.
 - ii. Safeguards can be defined to avoid one-company rule.
 - iii. Allowance of walk-in corner review must be identified.
- D. Geodetic coordinates to be collected. MCL 54.268 (2)(a)(iii)
 - i. Geodetic coordinates are not defined by the law. Some counties want to use State Plane Coordinates as defined in 1964 PA 9, and others want to use latitude and longitude. The county can decide which to use, but it must be consistent and documented.
 - ii. The storage of coordinate values must be addressed at the county level.
- E. Agreements for active geodetic control sites. MCL 54.268 (7)
- F. LCRC forms must be recorded at the county Register of Deeds and with the Department. MCL 54.268 (2)(b). This has not changed.

It is the intent of the Revision to review the Remonumentation Plan, assess its validity and modify for recent technologies. As shown in the outline, decisions must be made and formalized in the Revised County Plan to assure local control and consistency. Additions to this Revision can be made if a county would like to modify a section.

According to Section 8 (1), the deadline to file the Revised County Plan is March 1, 2020.

PERPETUAL MONUMENT MAINTENANCE PLAN

Upon entering the Maintenance status, corners will be revisited based on the recommendation of the County Representative. The County Representative shall recommend corners to be revisited taking into consideration the following factors:

- Available funding
- Preference for Corners with monuments that are known to have been disturbed
- Preference for Monuments located in populated areas of Baraga County; these monuments maybe visited/ revisited more frequently than those in rural areas or area with less fractured parcel ownership.
- Preference for GLO Corners over non-GLO Corners accepted into the County Program.
- Preference for Corners that don't currently have a geodetic coordinate on file with the program
- Consideration given to the number of years since last visited; based on records of corners submitted to the County Remonumentation program AND/OR subsequent non-Remon Act 74 ('s) being filed at the Baraga County Register of Deeds.

A Land Corner Recordation Certificate does not need to be filed with geodetic coordinates if all the following conditions are met:

- The monument exists "as described". (see definition of "as described" below)
- At least 3 existing witnesses remain.
- No additional information has been found to refute the location

For the purpose of the Perpetual Monument Maintenance Plan, and with reference to MCL 54.203 and MCL 54.203a, "as described" will be defined as follows:

- Monument [or Reference and/or Witness monument(s), where applicable], shall be considered as described if the material, size, and stamping information match that of the previous Remonumentation Record or subsequent non-remonumentation Land Corner record (Act 74) on file at the Baraga County Register of Deeds.
- Witnesses (Bearing Trees, Carsonite posts, Witness Objects, Reference monuments, monument boxes, and/or other Accessories) shall be considered "as described" if the accessory exists in a condition similar to the time of its initial reference. This definition allows variations, within reason, for previously noted bearings, distances, and Tree diameters (allowing for growth). Reference nails, witness signs, Carsonite posts, monument boxes, or the like may be restored (if needed) in the previously recorded location without compromising the "as described" status. Unless a Bearing Tree was previously noted as dead, a tree that is still standing but is now dead is NOT considered "as described".

APPENDIX CC
PEER REVIEW GROUP

The Baraga County Peer Group shall consist of a minimum Three (3) Land Surveyors licensed in the State of Michigan; including the County Representative whom serves as chair of the peer review group. All members of the peer group must hold a valid Professional Land Surveyors license issued by the State of Michigan. Peer Group Members will be selected to serve by the County Board, without an expiration date for their respective terms. Each Licensed Surveyor serving on the County Peer Group serves at the behest of the County Board, which may Add or Remove members as they see fit. If a member wishes resign from the Peer Group, for any reason, they may submit their resignation (in writing) to the County Administrator to be brought before the County Board for approval.

No more than One (1) Surveyor from the same firm may serve on the peer group. If a firm has multiple Land Surveyors, the individual on the peer group may request one or more Land Surveyors to fill in their position as an alternate. Alternate status must be approved by the County Board. An alternate Professional Surveyor can attend a meeting for a member of the peer review group as a proxy vote once per calendar year.

Peer Group meetings will be scheduled as needed; generally once a year. Subject to change once the Perpetual Monument Maintenance plan is initiated.

Contract surveyors are not required to be a member of the peer review group. Professional Surveyors submitting contract corners will be notified of our meeting schedule, and are required to have themselves or a designee attend a meeting at which corners will be presented for approval. If a surveyor who prepared the LCRC cannot present the corner to the peer review group, the presentation can be delegated to the crew chief or other Professional Land Surveyor who actively participated in preparing the document(s). Surveyors who are members of the peer review group cannot vote on corners they present.

If the county representative is also the county administrator, that individual and that individual's organization shall not enter into any Remonumentation surveyor contract within the borders established by the county plan.

Walk-in corners from any Professional Land Surveyor in the State of Michigan are acceptable. No fee will be paid for walk-in corners, but enough material to complete the Remonumentation of the corner can be shared with the Professional Surveyor once the corner position is accepted. Professional Surveyors submitting walk-in corners will be notified of our meeting schedule, but need not attend.

A corner will be considered "Approved" by the Peer Group, if a majority of the Peer Group approves of the position.

APPENDIX DD
GEODETIC COORDINATES

With respect to MCL 54.268 (2) (a)(iii), reporting of Geodetic Coordinates will be as follows:

- Geodetic coordinates reported will be in a degrees – minutes – seconds – decimal-seconds format for Latitude and Longitude.
- Accuracy of the coordinate will be within 1.0 feet.
- A database will be maintained by the County Representative.
- If a question of position arises, the distance from a witness will be weighted as more accurate than a geodetic coordinate.

In the event that the National Geodetic Survey, the State of Michigan, Baraga County, or some other entity configures a low distortion projection or other system deemed to an improvement over the above noted system, the Peer Group may elect to change the format in which coordinates are reported.

Grievance alleges 2 people bid for a full time position in Admitting and job was given to person who has only been employed for a little over a year with billing experience (Katie Tonge) and certifications and union feels Ms. Turpeinen (who has been employed for 17 years) should have been granted the position and given the opportunity for training.

Margie Van Haecke, Revenue Cycle Manager, was asked to speak regarding the review process of the applicants and the differences in the jobs Katie Tonge and Tina Turpeinen are currently doing. Ms. Turpeinen has worked in Medical Records for the past 17 years and recently has become a backup for the AP clerk posting payments. Ms. Tonge has been the private pay biller in the Collections department. Ms. Tonge is already familiar with the billing processes, various insurance screens and websites, can admit a patient and knows how to read a patient statement. Ms. Van Haecke chose the individual with the most experience and qualification to do the job, stating Ms. Tonge can recognize what is going on with a patient claim already, while Ms. Turpeinen is just posting payments. Ms. Van Haecke noted there is a difference between posting payments to an account and not knowing why and doing the billing process.

Ms. Jestila noted she independently reviewed the applicants and came to the same conclusion that Ms. Tonge would be better suited for the position as she can be acclimated faster to the department, hence getting more cash flowing into the hospital. She also noted Ms. Tonge's certifications did not come into play with the decision. Ms. Jestila noted the Collections Department and Billing Department go hand in hand.

Mr. Murphy argued Ms. Turpeinen should have been awarded the position because she is "at most" qualified and all positions are similar. Ms. Tembreull states that all jobs are trainable and

Ms. Turpeinen is equally qualified for the position. Ms. Tembreull noted that since Ms. Tonge has been awarded the position, her old position in Collections has been eliminated and "Everything worked out perfectly".

Ms. Younggren asked why Ms. Turpeinen was not given the opportunity to test for the position. Ms. Jestila stated the procedure has always been to awarded the position, then test the individual. If the individual does not pass the test, then the next qualified candidate is allowed to test. Ms. Tonge passed the test.

Ms. Wadaga in situations like this we have to rely on those who have experience in the department to make the best decision for who is the most qualified.

Ms. Tembreull stated Ms. Turpeinen and Ms. Tonge are equally qualified and according to the contract the job should have gone to the most senior employee, Ms. Turpeinen.

Ms. LaPointe argued how are they equally qualified? They currently have two very different job descriptions and Ms. Tonge already has billing experience.

After discussion and review, Ms. Wadaga made a motion seconded by Ms. LaPointe to deny the grievance as presented by Ms. Tembreull on behalf of Ms. Turpeinen. All in favor – motion carried.



RESOLUTION #20-03

“Stepping Up Initiative to Reduce the Number of People with Mental Illnesses in Jails” February 11, 2020

WHEREAS, counties routinely provide treatment services to the estimated 2 million people with serious mental illnesses booked into jail each year; and

WHEREAS, prevalence rates of serious mental illnesses in jails are three to six times higher than for the general population; and

WHEREAS, almost three-quarters of adults with serious mental illnesses in jails have co-occurring substance use disorders; and

WHEREAS, adults with mental illnesses tend to stay longer in jail and upon release are at a higher risk of recidivism than people without these disorders; and

WHEREAS, county jails spend two to three times more on adults with mental illnesses that require interventions compared to those without these treatment needs; and

WHEREAS, without the appropriate treatment and services, people with mental illnesses continue to cycle through the criminal justice system, often resulting in tragic outcomes for these individuals and their families; and

WHEREAS, Cheboygan County and all counties take pride in their responsibility to protect and enhance the health, welfare and safety of its residents in efficient and cost-effective ways; and

WHEREAS, Cheboygan County fully supports the concept of the *Stepping UP* initiative; and

WHEREAS, through *Stepping Up* , the National Association of Counties, the Council of State Governments Justice Center and the American Psychiatric Association Foundation are encouraging public, private and nonprofit partners to reduce the number of people with mental illnesses in jails;

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Cheboygan County Board of Commissioners, do hereby sign on to the Call to Action to reduce the number of people with mental illnesses in our county jail, commit to sharing lessons learned with other counties in my state and across the country to support a national initiative and encourage all county officials, employees and residents to participate in *Stepping Up*. We resolve to utilize the comprehensive resources available through *Stepping Up* to:

- Convene or draw on a diverse team of leaders and decision makers from multiple agencies committed to safely reducing the number of people with mental illnesses in jails.
- Collect and review prevalence numbers and assess individuals' needs to better identify adults entering jails with mental illnesses and their recidivism risk, and use that baseline information to guide decision making at the system, program, and case levels.
- Examine treatment and service capacity to determine which programs and services are available in the county for people with mental illnesses and co-occurring substance use disorders, and identify state and local policy and funding barriers to minimizing contact with the justice system and providing treatment and supports in the community.
- Develop a plan with measurable outcomes that draws on the jail assessment and prevalence data and the examination of available treatment and service capacity, while considering identified barriers.
- Implement research-based approaches that advance the plan.
- Create a process to track progress using data and information systems, and to report on successes. **PASSED AND APPROVED** on this 11th day of February, 2020.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to all Michigan counties, the National Association of Counties, the Michigan Association of Counties, and members of our State and Federal leadership.
